Materials and Methods

The technique I use to hand build my containers is slab construction. I use found objects to stamp onto and carve into the clay's surface. My glazing technique involves burnishing, washing, and staining the bisque pieces. I layer color to create vibrant contrast and sponge off color to create soft weathered finishes.

My work is a continuous exploration of the ways that common objects interact with clay. I am intrigued by the limitless possibilities of incorporating aspects of found objects onto ceramic surfaces giving these forms new life.
