Linny has created and designed her paintings on beautiful silk fabrics, using fiber reactive dyes and hot wax. The wax process is known as batik. Each layer of color and wax is applied many times, until a rich and varied surface texture is achieved. This technique allows her to build a dynamic network of colors with diverse shades and hues.
