As an artist I juggle between painting, sculpting and creating functional pottery. At the root of me I am a painter who loves to throw mud around finding and creating surfaces to paint on. I explore these surfaces by focusing on shape, color and line. The circles that are created were once eyes, and they have begun to morph into tunnels, figures and landscapes. The numbers 3 and 7 are a theme to my work. Religious questioning, creation, oneness and unity are the basis of these numbers. When I begin a piece I work intuitively with gestural under painting and printing. I then slow down and add brushwork details to pull out figures and landscapes with tunnels to future possible places.
